Shrop Archives Ref/ Notes gives the reference number for Shropshire Archives if the original document can be viewed there. This section also contains notes about the item if it is held at BCHRC e.g. fragile, number of sheets etc

Paper copies of the full catalogues for the records of these parishes held by Shropshire Archives are also available here.

As well as parish registers and records, we also have *Documents Concerning (Parish Packs)* and catalogues of material held at Shropshire Archives, We also have transcriptions of *Archdeacon Plymely's Visitation of South Shropshire* in the lates 1790s through to the 1830s. This will be completed for our parishes in 2011.

We have a wide range of *maps, including tithe maps and apportionments* and a series of photographs of original documents from Shropshire Archives, which can be viewed on computer.

We also have a small *reference library*, and can arrange access to items in the House on Crutches Museum reserve collection and items deposited in our store.

We have a copy of a full survey of monumental inscriptions in St John the Baptist churchyard in Bishop's Castle, including plans of the various areas of the churchyard and an index with locations.

We have a small selection of booklets produced by Montgomery Genealogical society, including parish church and non-conformist memorial inscriptions for Churchstoke,

Hyssington, Lydham, Mainstone, Sarn and Snead. We also have a few copies of parish registers in Powys, and a full catalogue of their publications.

ACCESS TO MUSEUM COLLECTION AND BCHRC DEPOSITS

Bishop's Castle Heritage Resource Centre is owned and run by the House on Crutches Museum Collection Trust (HOCMCT). We hold the museum's reserve collection in our museum-standard store, and artefacts and documents from the collection may be accessed by arrangement. The HOCMCT catalogue can be searched at BCHRC on the MODES

A number of local organisations and individuals have deposited their archives in our store, and many of these can also be accessed by genuine researchers by arrangement.

GUIDE TO SOURCES HELD ELSEWHERE

There are many locations (real or virtual) that can be used to research local and family history, and we cannot hope to list them all. However, the following sources will give you a starting point.

BISHOP'S CASTLE LIBRARY
